HISTORY AND FOUNDATION THE GL OF KAZAKHSTAN

Freemasonry in Kazakhstan The origins of Freemasonry in Kazakhstan date back to 1904, when Alikhan Bokeikhan, the first Kazakh Freemason and Prime Minister, together with other distinguished brothers of the Alash and Jadidchilar movements, laid the foundations of Masonic thought in our land. After decades of prohibition during the Soviet era, Freemasonry was revived in 2015, opening a new chapter of enlightenment and brotherhood.

On November 12, 2016, in the presence of delegations from several Grand Lodges of Europe and neighboring countries, the QAZAQ JOĖARY LOJASY was solemnly constituted in Almaty, establishing for the first time an autonomous and sovereign Masonic jurisdiction in Kazakhstan.

Later that year, on September 17, 2016, under its auspices, the Travelling Lodge “United Nomadic Brothers” No. 3 was consecrated — dedicated to fostering international fellowship, cross-cultural understanding, and mutual cooperation among Freemasons across all frontiers, embodying the nomadic spirit of unity, wisdom, and freedom.

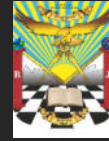
The following Symbolic Lodges are currently active under the jurisdiction of the GLoK

ABOUT US

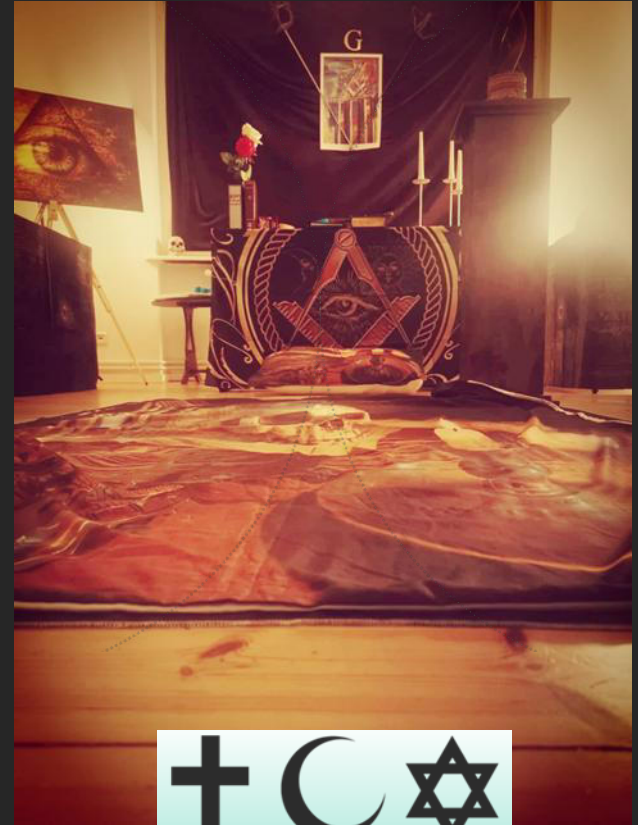
Faith in the Great Architect of the Universe is the foundation of the Masonic work of the United Nomadic Brothers Lodge №3 within the Grand Lodge of Kazakhstan, uniting Brethren regardless of their personal beliefs.

The Lodge was duly constituted on September 19, 2016, in the Orient of Astana (now the capital of Kazakhstan), in full accordance with the Constitution, Usages, and Ancient Landmarks of the Craft.

Working under the auspices of the Grand Lodge of Kazakhstan — a sovereign, regular, and internationally recognized Masonic authority — we bear the number 3 in the Register with honor and responsibility. As an English-speaking traveling Lodge, we hold no fewer than four meetings per year, at least half of which take place outside Kazakhstan, strengthening international bonds and fostering closer fraternal relations.

Our Lodge is a mosaic of cultures, professions, and traditions: among our Brethren are diplomats, officers, entrepreneurs, scholars, artists, and seekers. We are united not by politics, nationality, or religion, but by the call of the Spirit and the pursuit of light and self-transcendence.

For us, the Lodge is a Temple of Humanity — a space of silence, reflection, self-discovery, and Brotherhood. Here, there are no strangers — only Builders. Every Brother is both Apprentice and Master, Wanderer and Guide.



STANDARD OF THE UNITED NOMADIC BROTHER LODGE



The standard of the United Nomadic Brothers Lodge embodies the Lodge's mission, ideals, and heritage in the global Masonic tradition. The azure background symbolizes the boundless journey of enlightenment, while gold embroidery reflects light, wisdom, and timeless values.

Upper part: The square and compasses with the letter “G” stand between two temples, crowned by the motto Orient Mit Occident — unity of East and West — and framed by acacia branches, a symbol of purity and immortality.

Central element: A checkered floor represents life's path where light and darkness meet; above it, the radiant sun rises over a handshake, guarded by winged unicorns — symbols of honor and the Lodge's adventurous spirit.

Lower part: The columns Jachin and Boaz, topped by the sun and crescent moon, signify time's cycle and the harmony of opposites, framed by acacia ornamentation.

Ornamentation: Across the field, triangles of three dots mark the three degrees of Masonic perfection.

Motto: “*Occident meets Orient*” — East and West United — proclaiming a world without boundaries, united in the pursuit of light and brotherhood under the Great Architect of the Universe.



LOGO OF THE UNITED NOMADIC BROTHERS LODGE

The logo of the United Nomadic Brother Lodge embodies its spirit, history, and Masonic philosophy in a perfect circular form. The circle represents eternity and perfection toward which every Brother aspires. Colors: The gold ornament on a deep maroon background combines the light of wisdom with the strength of spirit. Gold symbolizes truth and spiritual wealth; maroon stands for dignity, honor, and fraternal devotion.

Symbolism:

- **Winged unicorns on each side — guardians of purity, honor, and ideals, with wings of freedom and horns of steadfastness.**
- **Checkered floor at the center — the path of life where light and darkness, joy and trials alternate.**
- **Rising sun — enlightenment and the triumph of knowledge over ignorance. Handshake — the bond of brotherhood and mutual support.**
- **Square and compasses with the letter “G” — spiritual discipline, moral rectitude, and a reminder of the Great Architect of the Universe.**



Inscription: United Nomadic Brothers arcs beneath the composition, proclaiming the Lodge's belonging to a brotherhood of traveling Brethren bringing light from East to West.

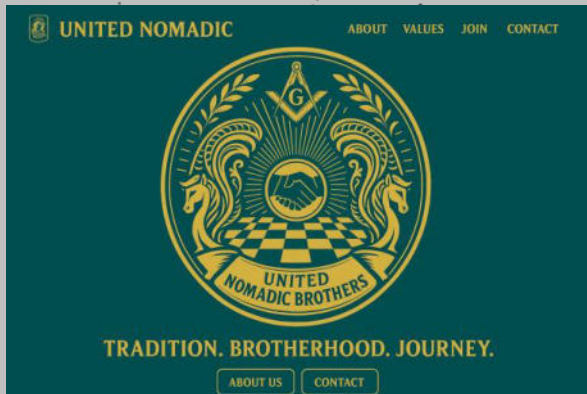
